User Manual for IP Camera's Remote View

Please refer to the notes below before use:

- 1. The IP camera can be used with a NVR for preview, recording and playback.
- The IP camera can also be used independently for preview. And if it supports TF card storage, it can also be used for recording and playback.
- 3. Before you use a new IP camera independently for video surveillance, you need to activate it first. You can activate your IP camera by mobile app, IE, SADP, PC software, or NVR.

If you want to use a new IP camera independently for video surveillance, please follow steps below:

Step 1: Download and install the mobile APP

1. Connect your phone to Wi-Fi, search and download APP "Annke Vision" from APP store or Google play. Then install and open the app.



 Click "Register" to sign up for an account by your mobile phone number or email address step by step, then please click "Login" after you registered successfully.

Step 2: Power on the device

Power on the camera with your DC12V power supply, connect the camera to your router with a network cable that can be connected to the Internet.

Step 3: Add the device onto your phone

1. Open the APP, click " 📩 " or the " + " button in the upper right corner to add the device. Scan the bar code in the label of camera or box.



 If the camera has not been activated before, it will prompt "The device is offline". Click "Connect to a Network", make sure the camera has been connected to a router, then click "Connected and Next".



3. Then it will connect to the network. Please set a device password to activate it, and keep it well.



4. Now please enable Annke Vision service. Tick "Read and Agree Annke Vision Terms of Service", click "next", then set a verifica tion code for your camera and keep it well. After that, please click "Enable Annke Vision Service".



5. Then the device will added to your account soon.

6. After the device is added, it will appear in the device list. You can click to access the live preview. You can also adjust the preview image resolution to HD, take snapshots, record to your phone, etc.



7. You can click the "..." button in the top right corner to access the camera's settings interface, modify the device name, change the time zone, etc. If the IP camera supports TF card, there will be storage status prompt the first time you insert the card. You need to click "Initialized" to format the new TF card before recording.
