


Figure 1-1 Overview of Type I Camera




Figure 1-2 Overview of Type II Camera




Figure 1-3 Overview of Type III Camera

2 Installation

Before you start:

- Please make sure that the device in the package is in good condition and all the assembly parts are included.
- Make sure that all the related equipment is power-off during the installation.
- Check the specification of the products for the installation environment.
- Check whether the power supply is matched with your power output to avoid damage.
- Please make sure the wall is strong enough to withstand three times the weight of the camera and the mounting.
- If the wall is the cement wall, you need to insert expansion screws before you install the camera. If the wall is the wooden wall, you can use self-tapping screw to secure the camera.
- If the product does not function properly, please contact your dealer or the nearest service center. Do not disassemble the camera for repair or maintenance by yourself.

2.1 Ceiling Mounting for Type I Camera



Both wall mounting and ceiling mounting are suitable for type I bullet camera. Ceiling mounting will be taken as an example in the section. And you can take steps of ceiling mounting as a reference if wall mounting is adopted.

Steps:

- 1.Drill the screw holes in the ceiling according to the supplied drill template.
- 2.Hammer the supplied plastic expansion bolt into the screw holes.




Figure 2-1 The Drill Template

3. Connect the corresponding power cable and video cable.
4. Fix the camera to the ceiling with the supplied screws.




Figure 2-2 Fix the Camera to the Ceiling

5. Adjust the surveillance angle.
- 1). Loosen No.3 adjusting screw to adjust the panning position ($0^\circ \sim 360^\circ$).
- 2). Tighten No.3 adjusting screw.
- 3). Loosen the No.2 adjusting screw to adjust the tilting position ($0^\circ \sim 180^\circ$).
- 4). Tighten No.2 adjusting screw.
- 5). Loosen No.1 adjusting screw to adjust the azimuth angle of the image ($0^\circ \sim 360^\circ$).
- 6). Tighten No.1 adjusting screw.




Figure 2-3 3-axis Adjustment

2.2 Installation of Type II Camera

Steps:

1. Drill the screw holes according to the drill template.




Figure 2-4 The Drill Template

2. Screw the clip plate onto the mounting base loosely.

3. Fix the mounting base to the ceiling with the supplied screws.
4. Route the cables through the side opening and connect the corresponding power cable and video cable.
5. Pull out the clip plate and secure the camera with the trim ring to the mounting base.
6. Push the clip plate in and tighten the lock screw to secure the trim ring.




Figure 2-6 Fix the the Camera





Figure 2-7 3-axis Adjustment

7. Adjust the camera according to the figure 2-7 to get an optimum angle and tighten the trim ring.

2.3 Installation of Type III Camera

Steps:

1. Drill the screw holes and the cable hole on the ceiling according to the supplied drill template.






Figure 2-8 The Drill Template

2. Fix the mounting base to the ceiling with the supplied screws.



3. Route the cables through the cable hole and connect the corresponding power cable and video cables.

4. Secure the camera to the mounting base and fix the trim ring to the camera, as shown in the figure below.



5. Adjust the camera according to the figure below to get an optimum angle.





Figure 2-11 3-axis Adjustment


Installationsprozess

- A. Einbau der Festplatte in die DVR. Verbinden Sie die DVR mit der Kamera nach dem Einschalten der DVR, um das gesamte Überwachungsgerät zu debuggen.
- B. Installieren Sie die Kamera und bestätigen Sie die Position der DVR.
- C. Verdrahten und verbinden Sie die Video-Anschlüsse von DVR und Kameras durch Video-Kabel.



Schritt 1: Unter der Voraussetzung, dass die Kamera mit normaler Leistung versorgt wird, bedecken Sie die Kamera mit Ihrer Hand, wie in Abbildung 2 dargestellt.

Schritt 2: Halten Sie für 10 Sekunden, dann Sie können die scharfe Schalter-Stimme aus dem Umschalter in der Kamera zu hören, wie in Abbildung 3 dargestellt.

Schritt 3: Entfernen Sie Ihre Hand weg von der Kamera und Sie werden die Bildfarbe wieder normal finden, wie in Abbildung 4 dargestellt.
